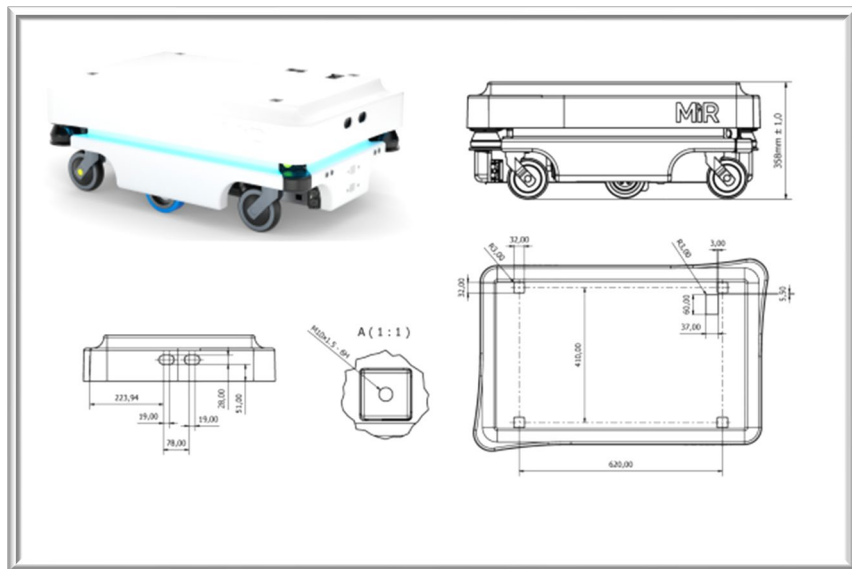

Function MIR100: self-propelled vehicle (battery)

MIR100 is an automatic vehicle that can transport materials internally within factories, warehouses, hospitals and a host of other industrial locations.

The user provides the destination of product delivery via a web interface. MIR100 can be up to run a fixed route or be called on demand besides more special operations.

MIR100 has a map that can be programmed the first time the vehicle is used. While operating, the MIR100 automatically avoids obstacles (people, furniture) that are not mapped.

MIR100's internal map contains specific locations (office, hall, John's room etc.) which can be used for logistical planning.

Each vehicle has its own network.

The vehicle is controlled from a website (HTML5), which is accessed via a browser on a PC, tablet or smartphone.

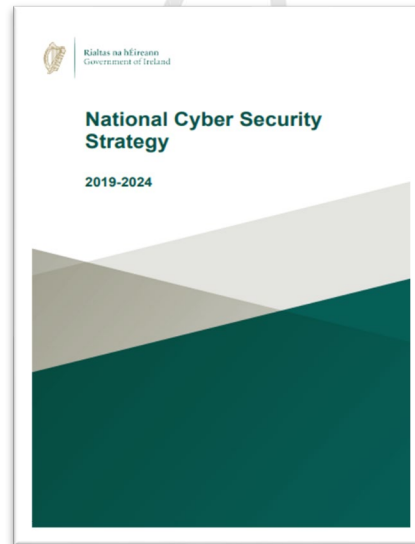

EU Cyber Resilience Act

This initiative aims to address market needs and protect consumers from insecure products by introducing common cybersecurity rules for manufacturers and vendors of tangible and intangible digital products and ancillary services.



Standards & Cyber Resilience Act

- The essential cybersecurity requirements in the proposal are building on widely used standards, and the standardisation process that will follow would take into account the technical specificities of the products.
- Conformity of the product with digital elements (Chapter III)
The product with digital elements, which is in conformity with harmonised standards or parts thereof, the references of which have been published in the Official Journal of the European Union, shall be presumed to be in conformity with the essential requirements of this proposed Regulation.



European Commission Work Programme

Each year the European Commission publishes an Annual Work Programme for European standardisation.

It lays down the Commission's intentions to use standardisation in support of new or existing legislation and policies and mandate the development of new standardisation deliverables to the European Standardisation Organisations CEN, CENELEC and ETSI.

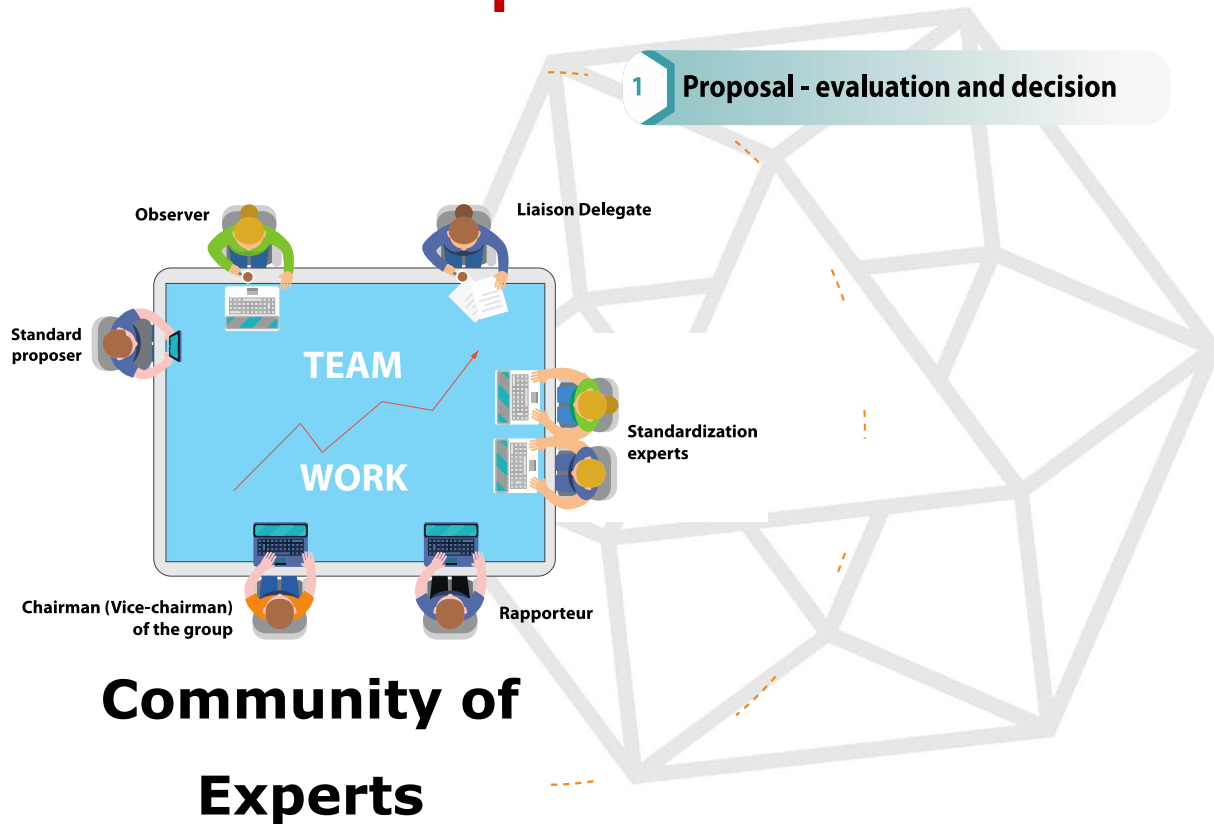

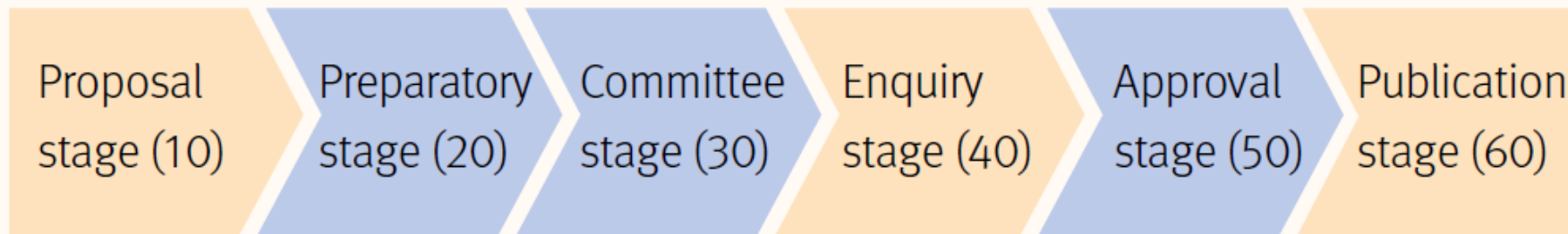

Harmonised Standards

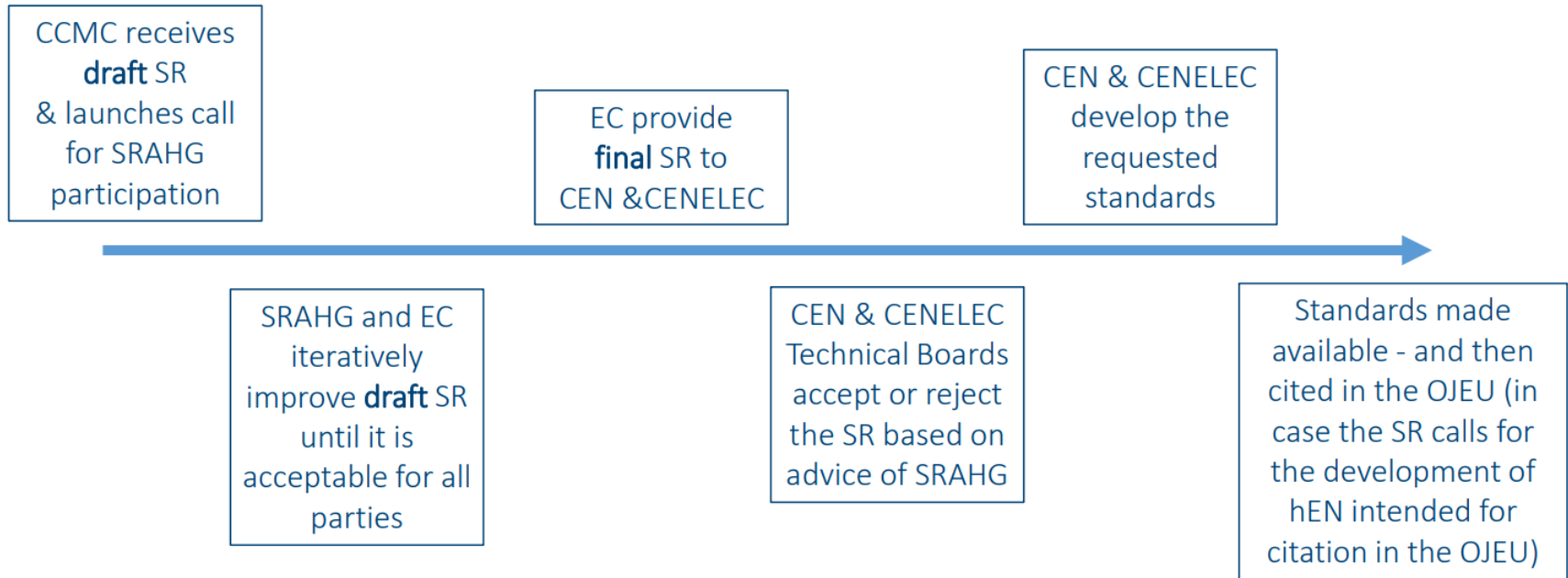
- ▶ A harmonized standard (hEN) is a European Standard (EN) developed in response to a formal Standardization Request (SR) of the EC

Two (main) types of hEN

- **Not for citation** in the OJEU
- Requested by the EC for example to address certain standardization gaps
- Can be a basis for the development of hEN that will be intended for citation in the OJEU

- **hEN intended for citation** in the OJEU
- Provide presumption of conformity (PoC) with EU legislation

RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS

General Conduct

Members shall behave in a way that facilitates the work of the Committee and in a manner that does not bring NSAI into disrepute.

General Conduct

POSITIVE

Committee discussions will be positive and constructive if the following points are followed:

- everyone has the right to courteous and open-minded treatment and for their views to be considered and respected,
- any conflicts of interest should be declared,
- confidentiality should be maintained.

General Conduct

The Committee shall determine its own quorum for meetings.

Normally a quorum is one half of the members for small committees and one third for large committees.

Getting Involved

You are representing your nominating organization and contributing their view to the Standards development process.

This is achieved by:

- reading documents circulated to the committee
- circulating new work proposals and drafts to your nominating organization so they can comment
- submitting your nominating organization's comments to the Committee Secretary
- attending meetings and participating in the **consensus** building process

Reminder: Consensus

“Consensus” is defined as general agreement characterised by the absence of sustained opposition to substantial issues by any important part of the concerned interests, and by a process that involves seeking to take into account the views of all parties concerned and to reconcile any conflicting arguments.

Consensus need not imply unanimity!

Responsibilities of Members

- Members are expected to advise and assist NSAI on the technical content of standards.
- Members are expected to prepare for and attend meetings and provide comments and submissions on active projects being developed.

IMPORTANT

Responsibilities of Members

- Members are expected to use the online platform (web based) for accessing documents related to the NSAI Committee. *(documents for committee work only – not for wider circulation/misuse).*
- A person applying for membership on behalf of an organization shall undertake to represent its viewpoint on issues discussed and act as a channel for consultation and communication with that organization.

Responsibilities of Members

- Membership of regional (CEN/CLC) or international committees (ISO/IEC)
 - when participating at those meetings, you should be aware of the national brief/position. Members are required to provide reports on attending those meetings.
- NSAI Committee members can make reference to their membership (including Chairmanship) when writing articles or giving lectures or papers. However, they shall not state views purporting to be those of the NSAI Committee, regional or international committees unless those views have been approved by the NSAI and/or NSAI Committee.

Responsibilities of Members

- Members should not commit NSAI to host meetings, without first consulting NSAI, and making a business case.
- Members should be aware that records of NSAI committees can be subject to disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act and that membership shall be disclosed, for example in annual reports.
- Members shall not communicate with the media on matters concerning the internal affairs of a Committee without expressed permission of NSAI.

Media

- Committee members should be aware of NSAI media contact policy.
- Media queries relating to the work of a NSAI Technical Body (including any Sub-Committees and Working Groups) are dealt with by NSAI PR.
- When a Technical Body wishes to communicate an agreed position on a particular matter to the media, this shall be done in co-operation with the Head of Standards and NSAI PR.

Intellectual Property Rights and Patents

- Common types of intellectual property rights (IPR) include copyrights, trademarks, patents, industrial design rights and trade secrets.
- NSAI, CEN, CENELEC, ISO and IEC retain the copyright of all Standards.

CEN and ISO Technical Committee Roles and responsibilities

- Establishes and agrees on its **programme of work** with precise title and scope of each project in accordance with its agreed business plans, if available.
- **Follows up** and ensures the achievement/delivery of the **work programme** and in accordance with the CEN strategic aim to develop standards "in production times needed by the market".
- Takes into account any ISO/IEC work coming within its scope, other relevant international organizations, and work on related subjects in any other Technical Committees (TC).

CEN and ISO Technical Committee Roles and Responsibilities

- Review all ENs within its responsibility at least every 5 years.
- Reviews other deliverables in accordance with the [Internal Regulations Part 2](#).
- At Plenary meetings, CEN national members are represented by a number of delegates, normally not exceeding three, one of whom acts as head of delegation (HoD). Other bodies may delegate observers to meetings.
 - Report of the Secretary and/or the Chairman
 - Report of the Convenors of the Technical Committee Working Groups:
 - Conclusions of these reports and actions to be taken
 - Environmental actions

CEN and ISO Working Group Roles and responsibilities

- A Work Group (WG) is established by a Technical Committee (TC) or Subcommittee (SC), that develops a draft deliverable(s) in the context of the scope and work programme of the parent body.
- It works within clearly defined policy guidelines from its parent body.
- The WG drafts documents in accordance with the work specifications, guidelines and time schedule provided by the parent body and in accordance with CEN drafting rules [Internal Regulations IR3](#).
- As required by the parent body, the WG is involved in the resolution of comments following the CEN enquiry and, if necessary, updates the draft.
- The WG provides technical advice to the parent body as required.

Duties of CEN or ISO Working Group experts

- The WG members are individual experts.
- They act in a personal capacity.
- They commit to provide the group with the best advice based on their knowledge and expertise.
- They inform the working group of any circumstance affecting the draft standards in development (risks, patents ...).
- They commit to abide by relevant CEN rules, in particular the CEN/CENELEC Internal Regulations.
- The WG members are invited to keep close contact with the CEN National Member of his/her home country. In particular, WG members are requested to be aware of national positions held at the parent body level.
- Need to be familiar with the drafting rules – [Internal regulations IR 3](#)

Reporting back to the national mirror committee

- **Good practice** - Produce a report to secretary for record and to raise at national committee meeting for feedback
- Advise national committee when casting votes on associated Committee Internal Ballots (CIBs), enquiry, formal vote etc.
- The main points to be covered in your report should be:
 - Technical discussion points
 - Questions to national mirror committee
 - Recommendations to national mirror committee
- Check with NSAI contact



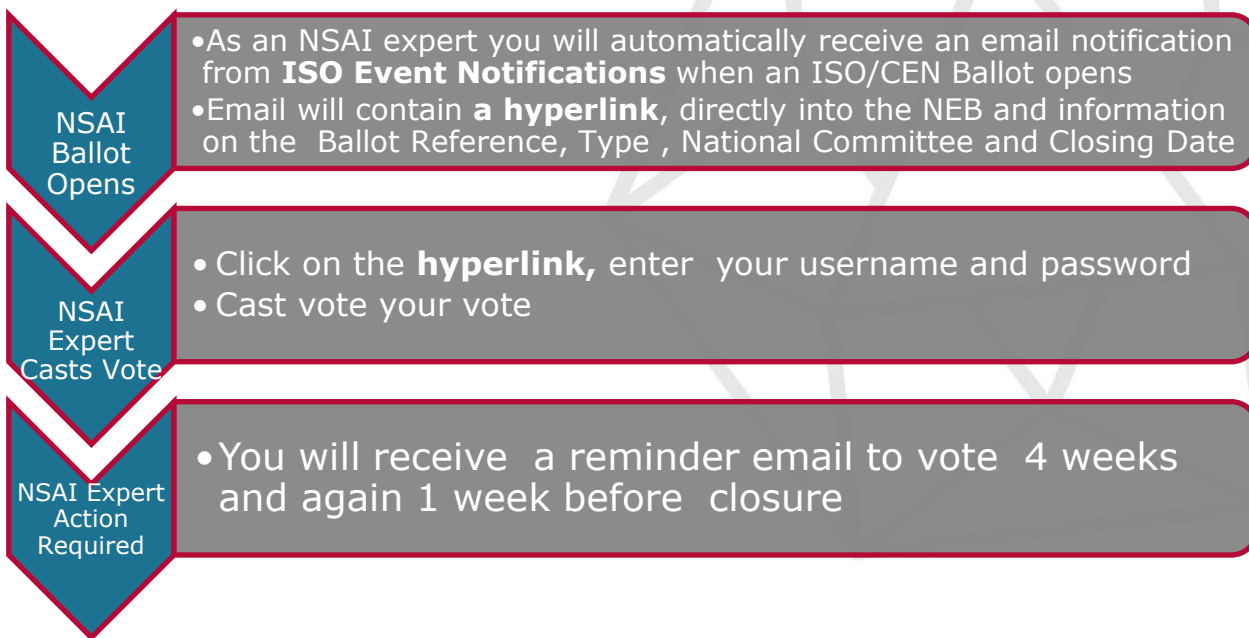

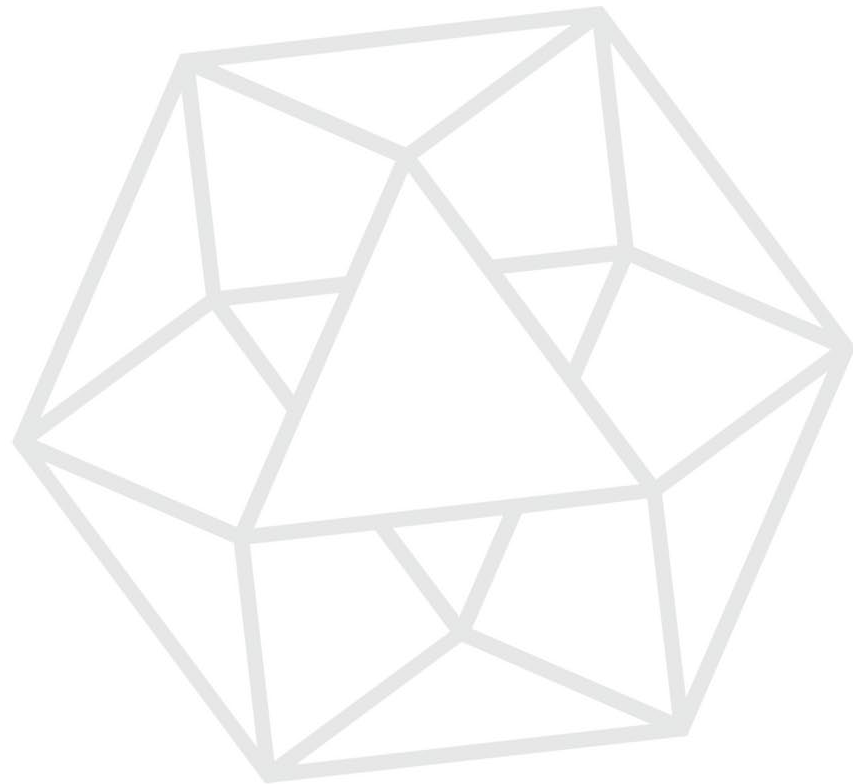
