

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2. Review of the Year 2018

The Committee meets twice a year usually just before the CENELEC TC 210 meeting. This year the committee met in May and December.

CENELEC TC210 is currently updating EN 50498 " Electromagnetic compatibility (EMC) - Product family standard for aftermarket electronic equipment in vehicles". This European Standard specifies limits and methods of measurement for disturbance emissions and immunity characteristics of aftermarket electric/electronic sub-assemblies (ESAs) intended to be fitted in motor vehicles. The aim of this CENELEC European Standard is to <u>consider-take into account</u> the replacement of the EC automotive directive by the UNECE Regulation 10. Also, more stringent performance criteria for EMC immunity testing shall be defined within this new standard.

There is still some delay in the adoption of harmonised standards by manufacturers in the area of EMC as the updated versions have not been listed in the Official Journal however, with the increased number of HAS (Harmonised Standards) consultants, this is expected to improve in 2019.
